PAKISTAN INTERFERES IN AFGHANISTAN POLITICAL PROCESS YET AGAIN

In a private briefing to foreign ministers of some NATO member States, Pakistani Officials have said that the Taliban are winning the war in Afghanistan and that NATO is bound to fail. The officials also advised NATO against sending more troops to Afghanistan and urged them to form a new government that might exclude Afghan president Hamid Karzai.

These expressions once more reveal the real intentions of Pakistan. The president and Afghan government officials have warned Pakistan at several instances about their malicious interference in Afghan internal politics. Subsequently Pakistan aims to bring its devotees back on the power and change Afghanistan to its strategic depth. These comments are certainly against the will of Afghanistan and the international community.

Whilst we highly condemn opinions of this nature, we once more like to state that only people of Afghanistan decide about the members of their government. The time when others were deciding about our destiny, is gone now. We are for coexistence and respect to the right of national sovereignty of other countries. Same as we do not interfere in the internal affairs of other countries, we will not allow others to interfere in the internal affairs of our country.
